*PEDC Investors,*

*Currently the Town Council has appointed a Blue Ribbon Committee to look into the current police station and possible funding options for a new facility. They will be presenting their findings to Council on July 14<sup>th</sup> at which time Council may decide on a resolution to ask voters to decide a November 2008 ballot measure about an annual property tax increase (with a sunset clause) to construct a new Parker Safety Center. While the Town of Parker has done a great job with the taxpayer dollar, it is now in need of some major capital construction: an approximate 90,000 sf Parker Safety Center in Lincoln Meadows which includes the Police Department, Courts, and community rooms.*

*In preparation for this Parker Safety Center Campaign our fundraising target is \$25,000. The Downtown Development Committee has worked actively to advance the project by committing \$16,000 for the campaign. The Parker Economic Development Council has adopted a resolution in support of the construction of a new Parker Safety Center in Lincoln Meadows (see attached).*

*At the last board meeting a decision was made to advance the campaign \$15,000 (taken from organizational reserves). It was also determined to allocate this year's net golf proceeds to the campaign as well. Our goal is to raise the remaining \$10,000 through our golf tournament. Here are some ways you can help support this effort:*

- 1) Sign up for a foursome and invite prospective PEDC investors to play in the PEDC golf tournament to be held on Friday, June 27<sup>th</sup> at Black Bear Golf Club.*
- 2) Sponsor and help find additional sponsors for the golf tournament. The more successful the golf tournament is, the more funds we will be able to forward on to the campaign.*


